5. Are there any areas in your life that are “not producing” fruit.



PRAY

one another

Turn to each other and make the sign of the cross on each others forehead. Look at each other and say, “ may you always turn to God.”

FAITH IN THE WORLD

Go outside and find a stick and some snow. Think of a time when you placed blame on another person, or a time when you have not loved others. Use your stick to write or draw a symbol of this time in the snow. * Today we are repenting by writing in the snow. We are recognizing our wrongdoings, and admitting them to ourselves and to God. Use your hand to wipe away the snow as a way of admitting our wrongdoings and giving them to God.
