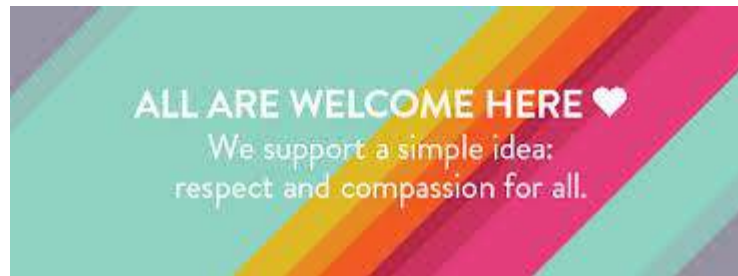
Joyful News August 16th - September 6th, 2026
