God's Name
Is Revealed



Pray: Light a candle and open your devotion time with a prayer.

Holy God, your promises stand fast forever. Make us bold to trust where you lead, and put our unflinching hope in your faithfulness. In the name of Jesus, Amen.



Read: Read the key verses from Sunday's reading.

¹³But Moses said to God, "If I come to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your ancestors has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?"¹⁴ God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." (Exodus 3:13-14)



Reflect: Reflect on the scripture summary.

The God of enslaved Israel is about to make good on an ancient promise, and has a special job for his servant Moses. This would-be hero, however, is less than enthusiastic.



Connect: Connect in conversation with others in your household.

What was a high point of your day? What was a low point?

Tell of a time you had to wait a really long time for an answer from God. What happened when the answer finally came? If you are still waiting, what answer are you hoping for?

Wonder: What did God mean by, "I Am Who I Am"? Consider that "I Am" is a state of being, not a state of doing.



Bless: Close your devotion with a blessing.

May God answer your prayers. Amen.
