**Friday:** *Crucifixion (Good Friday)*, Luke 23:32-47

**Saturday:** *Burial of Jesus*, Luke 23:48-56

**More resources for being the church at home this week**

Jesus' long anticipated arrival in Jerusalem is met not by an angry mob, but rather a raucous parade singing his praises. However, the master's eyes can see only certain demise – of himself, and finally, the city itself.

**A meal time prayer:**

**More questions for conversation:**

1. When has the movement of a crowd gotten swept away and out of hand? Why do you think mob mentality has so much power of people? What is happening in your congregation that is being swept away by such momentum? What needs to change to turn the momentum?
2. What are you willing to give or do to follow Christ? What can you do this week that pushes you beyond your comfort zone?

**Ideas for putting faith in action:**

By acting on what we learn we make God's word come alive.

Focus on making a set of long and short-term goals with each other. Be sure to check in on each other's progress from time to time.

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
